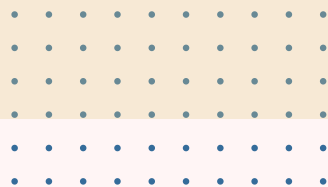

Date: 9th June, 2023.

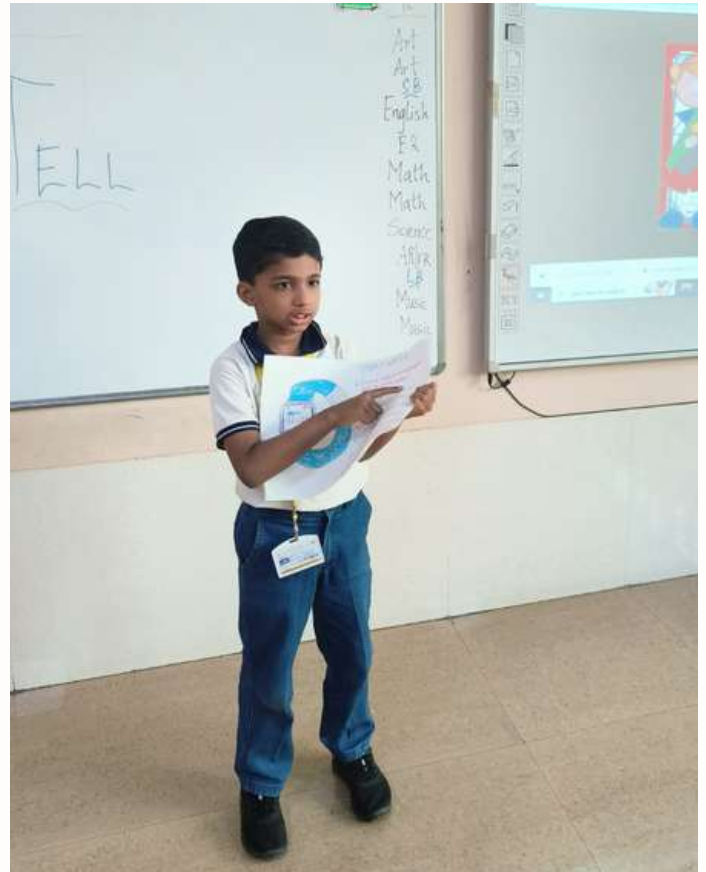

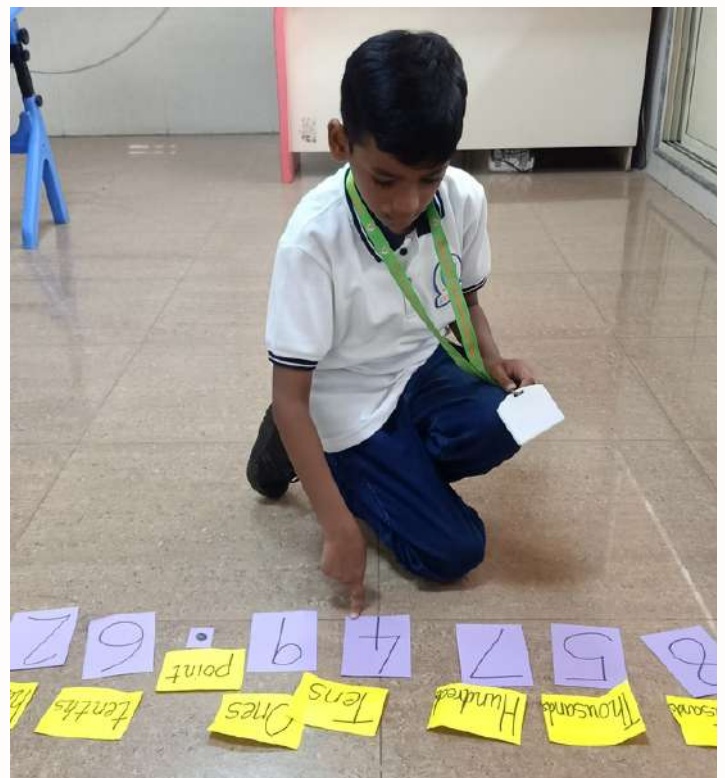
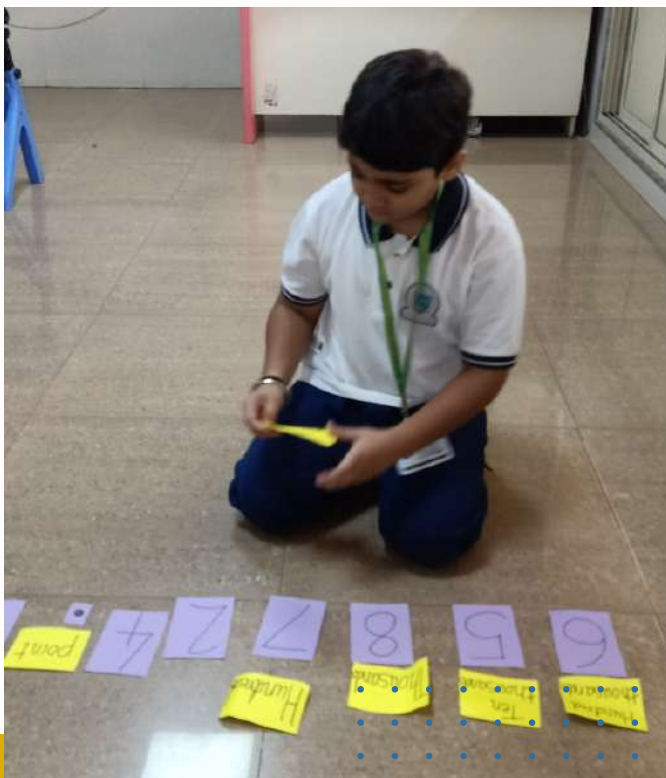
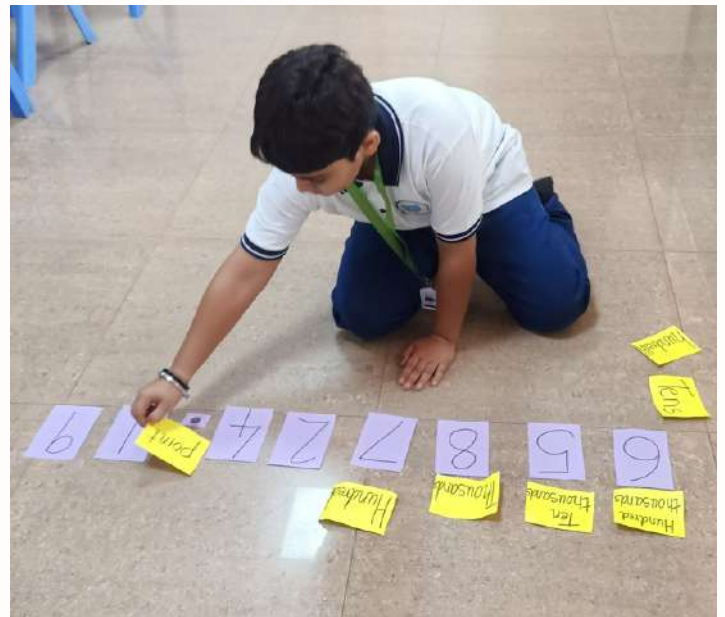
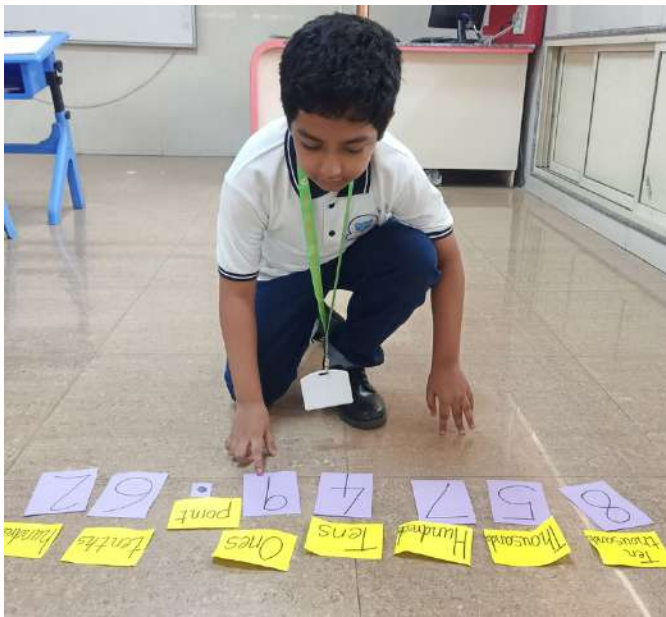
SHOW AND TELL - GRADE II

MAKING CVC WORDS - PREP II

Making CVC words using moveable alphabet box.

At TSGE we have fun while developing the learners creative thinking and practicing hand-eye coordination. The large moveable alphabet is a versatile Montessori material because of its endless learning extensions. Prep II learners were working on their reading, writing, and spelling skills which helps them to increase their language competency.



SHAPES ACTIVITY HANDS ON - PREP I

One of the very first math lessons in early years is dimensional shapes! Prep I learners explore shapes by making various shapes with popsicle sticks. analyzing each shape manipulative, copying, thinking, comparing and predicting, Fine motor skills (picking up the popsicle sticks, building)



NUMBER AND IT'S QUANTITY - PREP II

One-to-one correspondence focuses on the actual counting of objects, and assigning numbers. At TSGE Prep II learners, visited the math lab for a fun learning activity to understand number and its association.



RANGOMETRY - PREP I

We are beginning to learn about shapes, spaces, and locations—basic concepts of geometry. At TSGE Prep I learners used geometric thinking when they build with blocks, assemble a floor puzzle, or play a target game. The learners were engaged with rangometry in a play way method.



MONTESSORI ACTIVITY- ROLLING AND UNROLLING OF MAT

Rolling and Unrolling of the mat- How a simple Montessori activity helps in strengthening the finger muscles and coordination. At TSGE we follow Montessori pedagogy as It enables the learners to perform their tasks independently and lend a hand in the daily household chores. It helps in increasing concentration. The rolling of mat is preliminary activity in Montessori as it helps to develop order and hand-eye coordination.



PRACTICAL LIFE SKILLS (POURING ACTIVITY) - NURSERY

Our learners need to learn “life skills”. That means, we might need to step back for a hot second and let them learn how to do things on their own. At TSGE we practice these life skills by giving our learners various different activities one of them being the chance to pour. It is so much more than just pouring water. They are working on, Hand-eye coordination, Grip strength, Spatial awareness, Capacity (how much water can each cup hold?) Cause and effect, Reasoning and Problem solving.



SNEH SETU NGO

The ground floor atrium of T.S.G.E school witnessed an inspirational event on June 16, 2023.
