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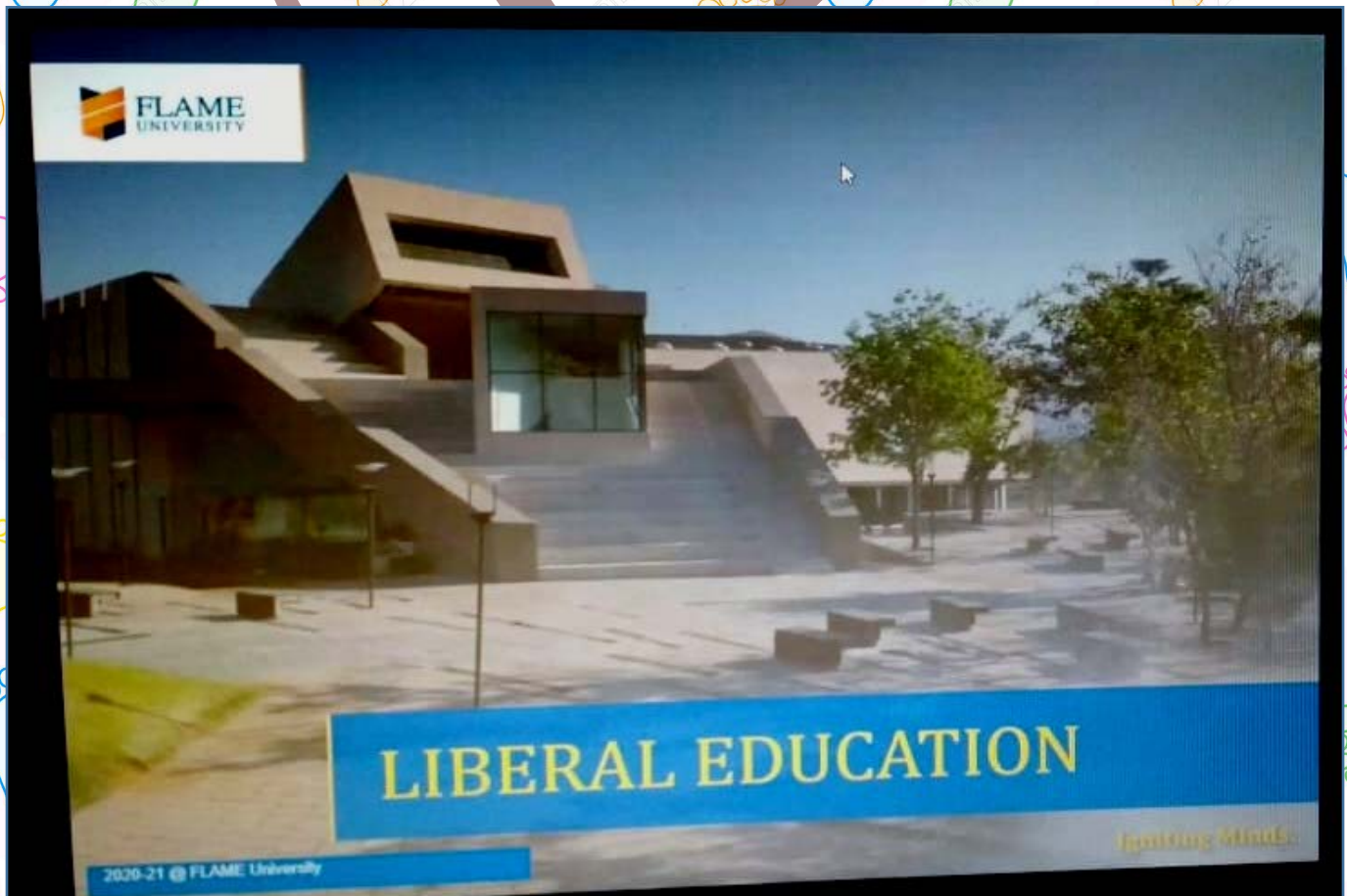


Liberal Education – FLAME University

All tapped their feet on the songs of Gokulasthmi and that is how the celebration was a grand success.

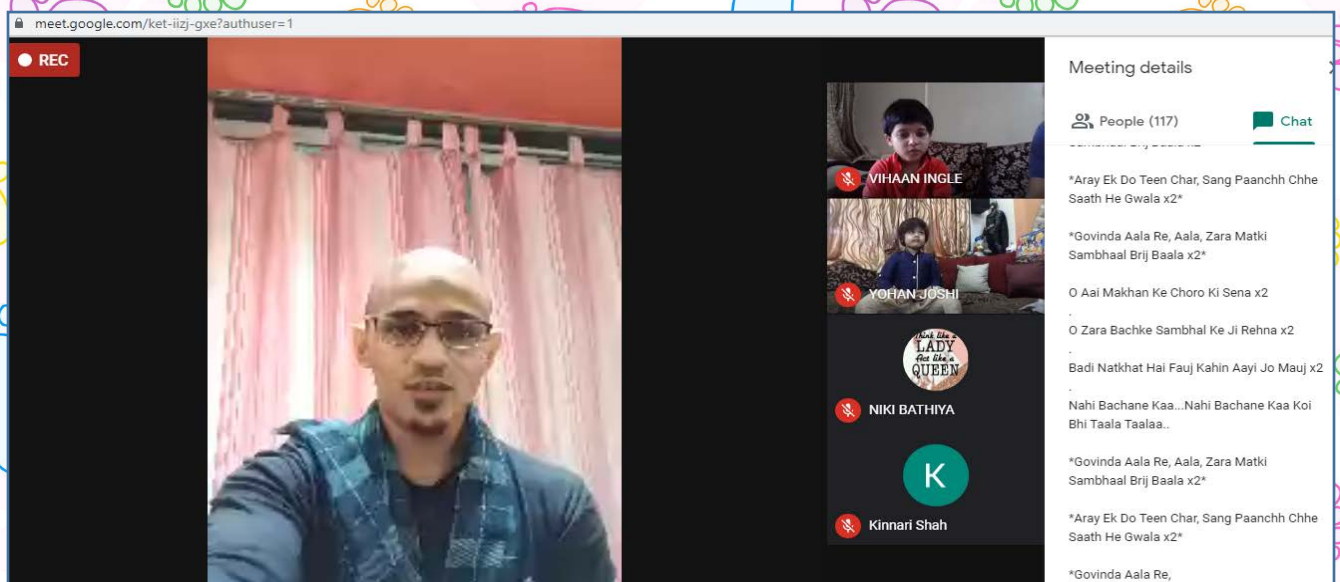




Janmashtami Celebration

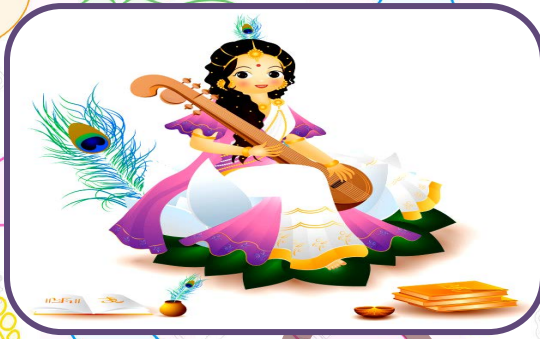




Independence Day Celebration

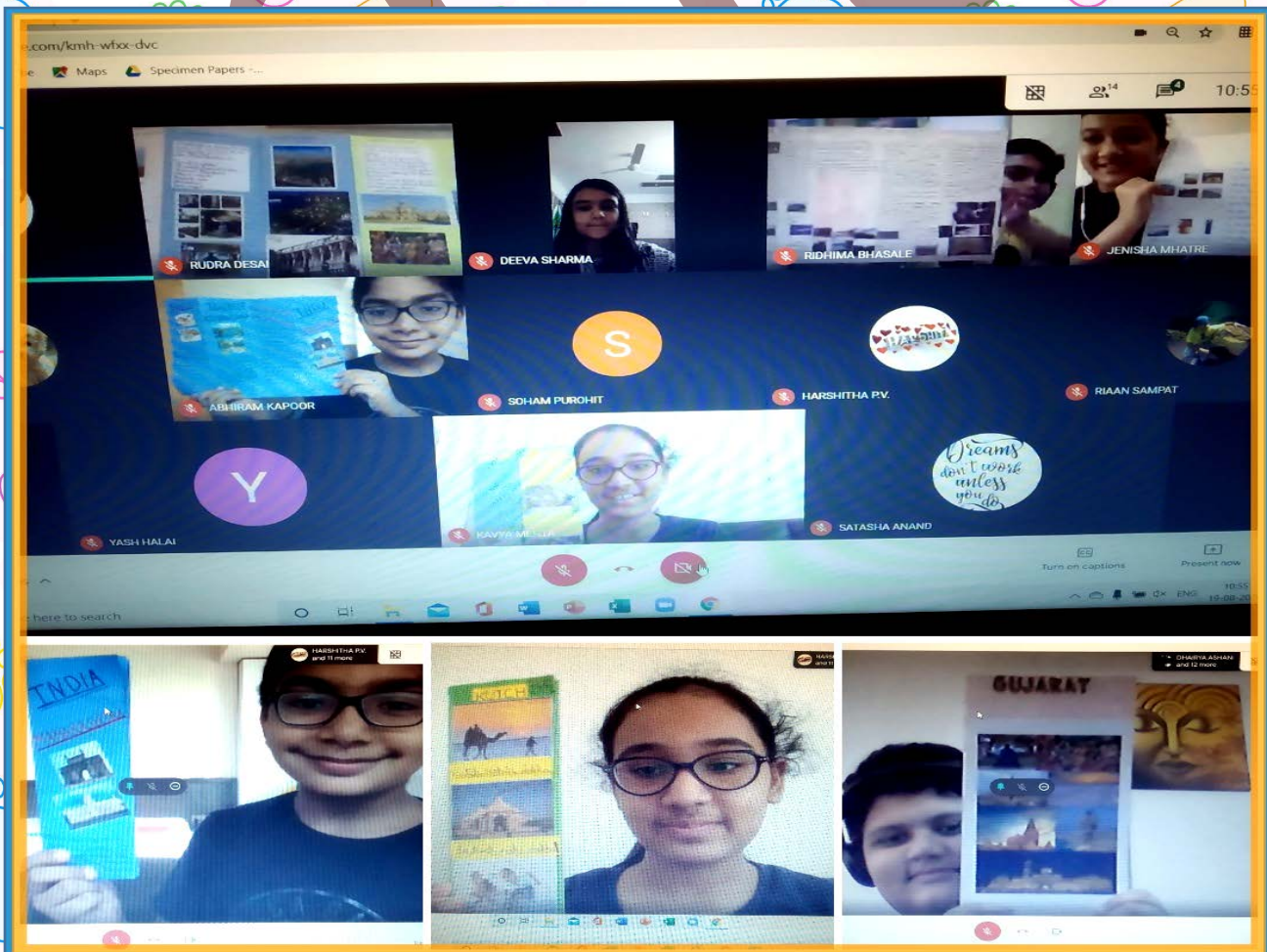

 Travel is often associated with leisure and entertainment as the holiday season sees a lot of us packing our bags. Media journalists often have to travel to get the latest "scoop"

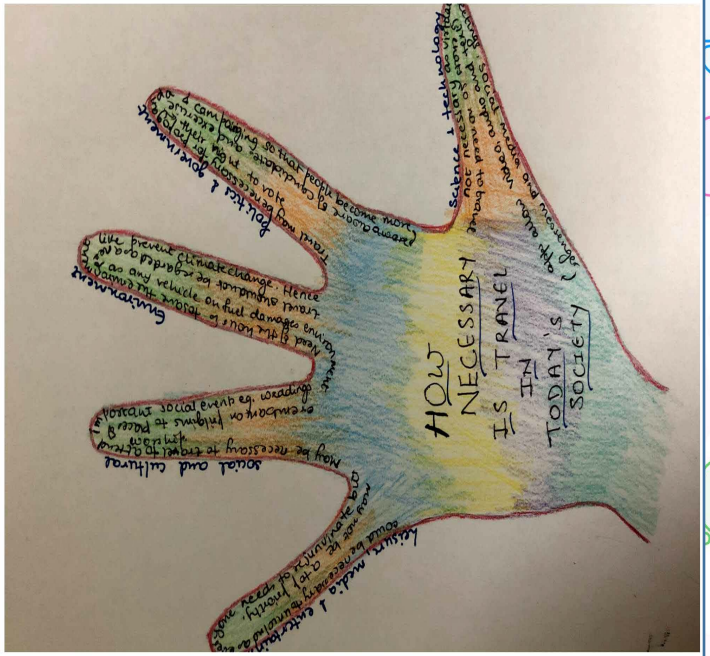
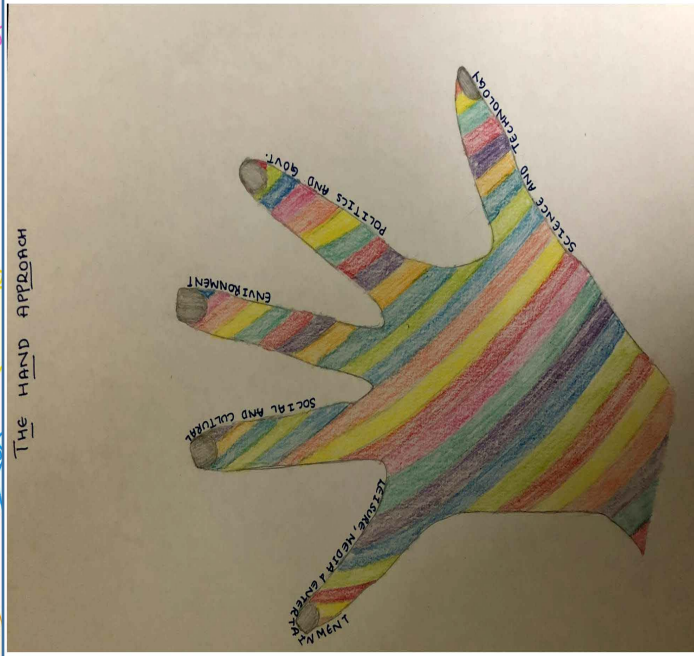
Politics, Government

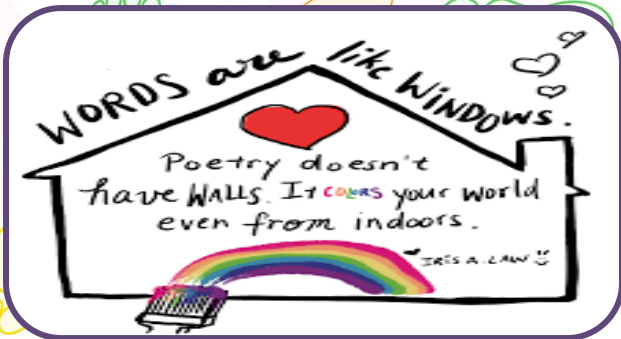

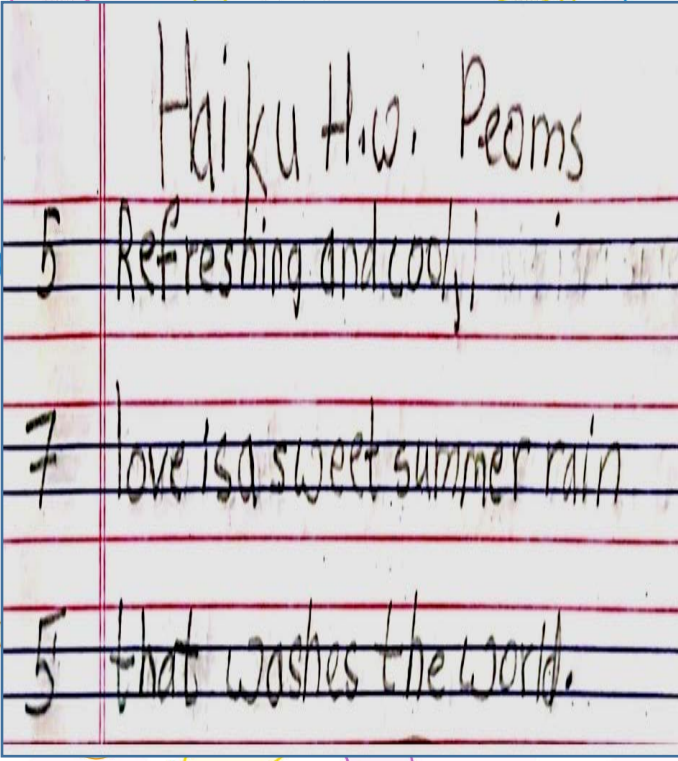
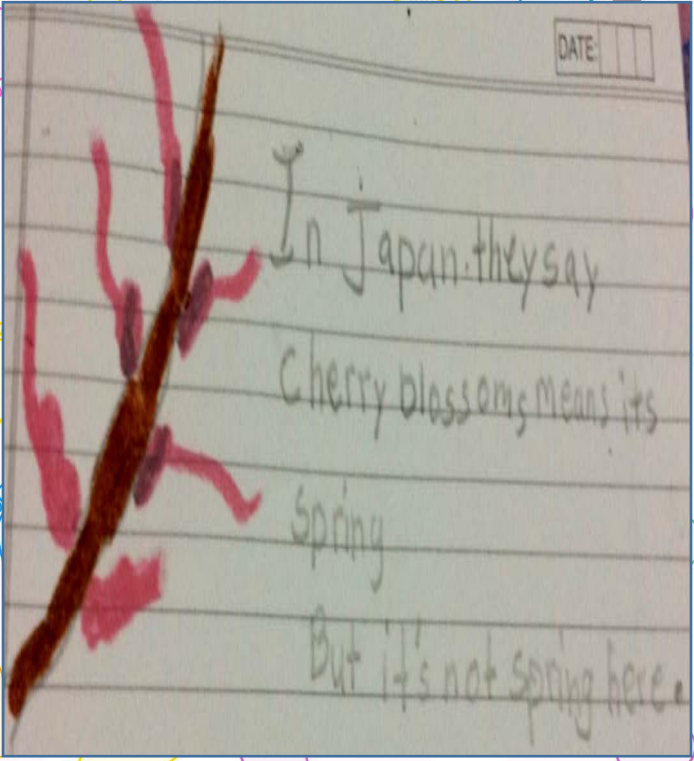
