The learners of TSGE attended the Leadership series organised by I.I.M.U.N. on 15th of July. The learner went to YK Chavan Auditorium for the conference.

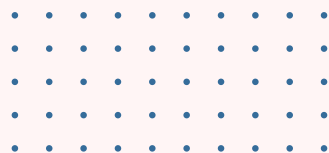

Mr. Terence Lewis spoke about integrating dance into the curriculum and the career opportunities it can offer. He shared his personal story of facing failure before achieving success.

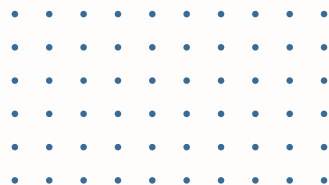
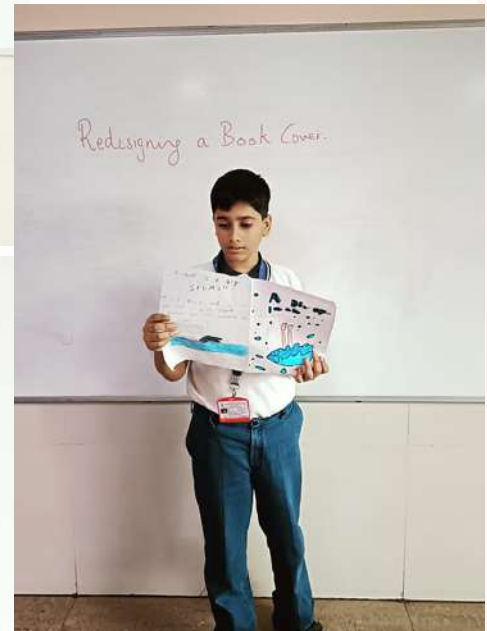
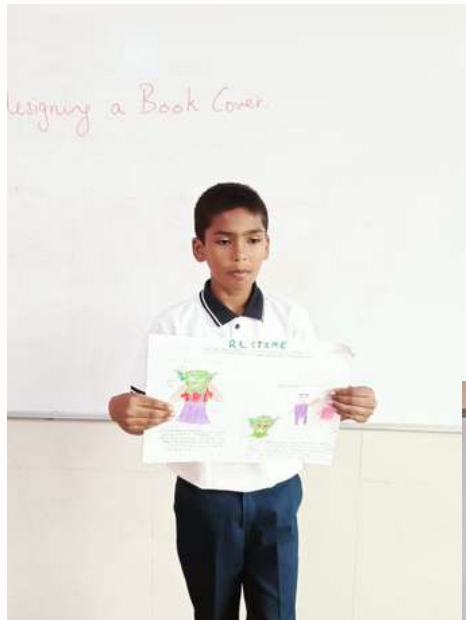

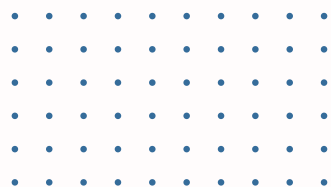
FRENCH DAY CELEBRATION

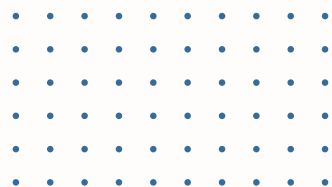

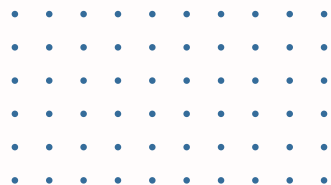

Samarth by Hyundai Grade I to A Levels

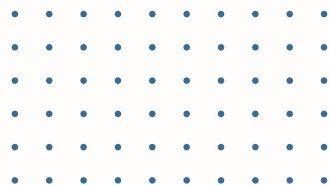

Grade X to A Levels

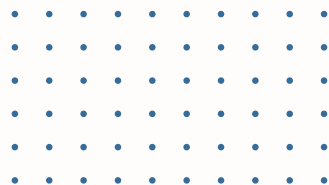

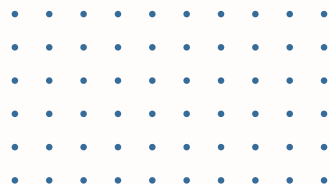
LogiQids

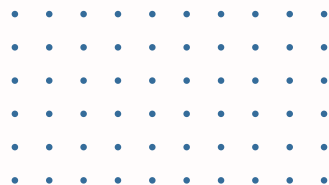


Circle Time
