I am excited to share some highlights from our recent Grade 4 science investigation, 'Flowing Solids ."

Curious Minds in Action! Our Grade 4 learners conducted a fascinating investigation into the flow properties of solids. Using everyday materials like wheat flour, sand, salt, sugar, and gram flour, they explored texture by touch—identifying each as rough or smooth—then measured how long it took for 100 ml of each solid to flow through a funnel. Results were recorded and visualized in a graph, showcasing the unique flow rates of each material. A fun, hands-on way to learn about the properties of solids!" Grade IV _ "Changing the Shape of Water."

Curious Minds in Action: Investigating How Water Changes Shape! Through hands-on exploration, they discovered how liquid particles move and adapt to the shape of each container. A fun and educational dive into the world of liquids!"








Education Augmented Reality
